We are partnering with Wodonga TAFE to offer a program for school leavers interested in the Care Sector that provides insight into Health Care, Social Services and Early Years Professions.

Over a 12 week period commencing late April participants will complete a First Aid Certificate and Safe Food Handling Certificate as well as units towards the following qualifications:

 **HLT43015
Certificate IV in Allied Health Assistance**

Support allied health care professionals such as physiotherapists and podiatrists as part of a healthcare team caring for patients.

 **CHC30113
Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care**

Take your passion, knowledge, and great sense of adventure, and share that with the toughest critics you will ever face in Early Childhood.

 **HLT33115
Certificate III in Health Services Assistance**

Work in a hospital or healthcare facility providing assistance in the care of patients, under the supervision of health professionals.

 **CHC33015
Certificate III in Individual Support**

Make a difference in people's lives - help them to become more active and maintain their fitness and agility, and support them to maintain their independence and standard of living.

Eligibility Requirements: Aged 15-24 and signed out of school. Willing to commit to 3-4 days weekly over 12 weeks.

Work experience will be in Medical, Health Care, Early Childhood and Individual care facilities.

*Please note this program is registered through the Multi Industry School-based and Pre-Apprenticeship Support Pilot Project and as such is bound by the eligibility requirements.
