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UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI)

From 1 January 2015, all students studying qualifications are required to register for a Unique Student Identifier (USI) before enrolment. The USI is a Government initiative that will allow you to access all your training records in one place. TAFE NSW Albury Institute (RTO ID 90005) requires your USI to complete your enrolment.
